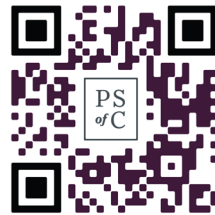
Step into Charleston's living history!

INSIDER'S ARCHITECTURE & HISTORY TOURS

Insider's Architecture & History Tours take guests inside some of Charleston's finest buildings, seldom open to the public. These tours are led by noted professionals such as architects, historians, and preservation experts with in-depth interpretation focused on Charleston's unique architectural styles, preservation ethic, and interior design. Each tour includes a unique set of 3 - 4 properties with a refreshments stop and lasts approximately 2.5 hours.

INSIDER'S GARDEN TOURS

The Insider's Garden series is designed for garden enthusiasts and are led by notable professionals such as landscape architects, garden designers, and horticulturalists. In addition to visiting some of the city's most beautiful private gardens, guests will also learn about subjects ranging from the latest gardening trends, to Charleston's vast horticultural history, and its diverse flora and fauna. Each tour includes a unique set of 4 - 5 gardens with a refreshments stop and lasts approximately 2.5 hours. **\$150 for PSC Members | \$200 Non-Members* (includes 1-yr membership)**
